The program is about choices and consequences and focuses on the development of respect, discipline, integrity, and responsibility. The program is delivered by police officers through classroom lectures, guest speakers, physical activities, physical training, community service and field trips.

The time and date of the 24 hour motivational camp will be disclosed to parents participating in the program during a parent orientation meeting approximately 12 weeks prior to the beginning of the program. After camp students will attend the program every Sunday for 20 weeks, from 7am to 3pm. Parents of students are required to attend 3 hours of parenting classes, once a week for 20 weeks.

The program is open to at-risk youth 12-15 years old, male and female. The cost of the program is \$400.00, which pays for boot camp meals, uniforms, drug testing, workbooks and parenting classes. Payment is non-refundable and is due prior to the first day of the program. If you are interested in enrolling your child in this one-of-a-kind innovative program
